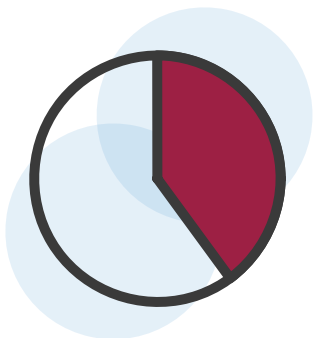


# How to make energy procurement a board level issue

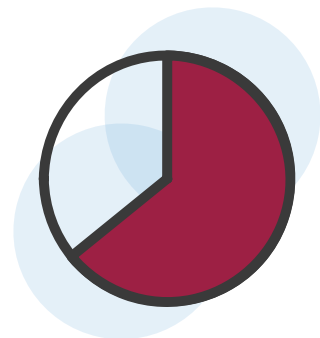
**Energy procurement is becoming more strategic - it's no longer just about the commodity charges**



Historically, charges have been split 60:40 - **60%** commodity charges and **40%** non-commodity charges.



Increases in third party charges mean that this is changing.



For electricity, the split is now more likely to be **40%** on commodity and **60%** on non-commodity.

Aging infrastructure in the UK requires investment of **£215 billion** by 2030



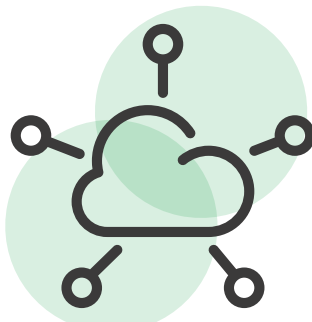
### Environmental

Government target is to reduce carbon emissions **57%** by 2030 on 1990 levels

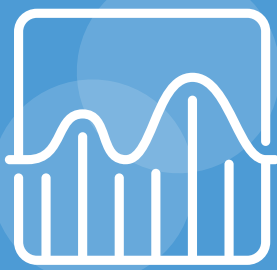

## The risks of not having an energy procurement strategy in place

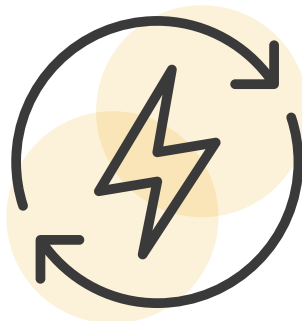


The market can fluctuate by up to **5-7%** in a single day
